Toilets

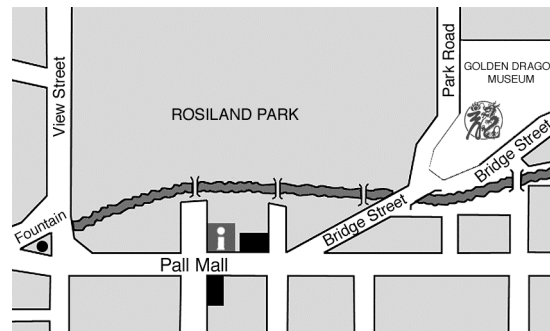
These are located in the foyer. A wheelchair accessible toilet is located next door to the ladies toilets.

A BRIEF HISTORY

Bendigo's Chinese heritage is an integral part of its rich cultural history.

From the goldrush period to the present day, the Bendigo Chinese community has influenced the proud history of Bendigo – from its tradition of charitable works for the local hospitals to its spectacular displays in the Bendigo Easter Festival.

Born of the long association with the people of the region, the Bendigo Chinese Association is proud to present the GOLDEN DRAGON MUSEUM – a living history of the Chinese people of Bendigo from the Goldrush to the present day.

Having become the hub of Chinese cultural activity in Victoria, the Museum allows visitors to experience first hand, the Chinese community in Bendigo – a unique history.

Central to the permanent display is Sun Loong, the longest imperial dragon in the world (over 100 meters long), Loong reputed to be the oldest imperial dragon in the world, and their associated regalia which were previously only viewed by visitors to the Bendigo Easter Festival, but now available to the general public all year round.

A donation to the Museum or its collections allows for new exhibitions to be mounted & continues to support travelling displays. Donations of family histories, enhances the understanding of life on the goldfields and the struggles of later generations.
